Everyone has a Toilet Story. For some in our community, though, this lack of adequate toilet access is a daily hurdle. Toilet Equity is working to change that.

We provide compost toilets around town for use by anyone who needs better toilet access. Primarily, this means we serve the unhoused population of the Grand Valley. Equitable toilet access is crucial for human safety and dignity. Open defecation creates a public health and environmental hazard for those that live and recreate in the Grand Valley. Beyond that, at Toilet Equity, we believe everyone deserves a safe, private place to do their business. Having to duck into an alley or squat in a field to defecate is stressful and potentially dangerous. Everyone should have reliable access to a toilet.

Toilet Equity toilets are donor-funded, volunteer-built, and volunteer-maintained. Our volunteers round on our toilets every day to ensure that they are clean, fully-stocked, and safe for our users and the surrounding community.
